The German 20 Euro Cent coin features the Brandenburg Gate on the obverse, symbolizing the division and later unification of Germany. The reverse side, common to all euro cent coins, depicts a map of the European Union, with the value "20 EURO CENT".

Composition:
Despite its gold-like color, the 20 cent coin is made of "Nordic Gold," an alloy primarily composed of copper, aluminum, zinc, and tin, containing no
